## Campaign Updates

### **With Grateful Hearts surpasses \$13 Million!!!**

This week, the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign received 164 pledges for a total of \$587,970! To date, the Bloc I parishes have raised \$7,378,803 from 990 pledges – 81% of the Bloc I Goal! **The campaign has now raised \$13,263,138 from 2,482 gifts.**

Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for your hard work!

## Good News

### **Immaculate Conception in Lihue, Kauai is OVER GOAL!!**

Fr. Bill Shannon and his team raised \$57,200 from 23 gifts this week, 20% of the parish goal!! The new total for Immaculate Conception is **\$331,730 from 83 gifts**, an average pledge of \$3,997 and **116% of goal!!**

Congratulations to **St. Catherine** on Kauai. This week Fr. Ramelo and his volunteers collected **\$64,550 from just 9 pledges - a 12% week!** The new total for St. Catherine is **\$503,200 – 96% of goal!!**

**St. John Vianney** in Kailua, Oahu raised \$95,600 from 12 pledges this week – including one for \$30,000 – to bring the total raised to **\$496,929 from 51 gifts**. Fr. Tom Gross and his team have raised **70%** of the \$875,000 goal!!
