Campaign Updates

With Grateful Hearts surpasses \$14,000,000!!!

This week, the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign received 255 pledges for a total of \$692,102! To date, the Bloc I parishes have raised \$8,637,310 from 1,395 pledges – 95% of the Bloc I Goal! **The campaign has now raised \$14,519,755 from 2,887 gifts.**

Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for your hard work!

Good News

St. Catherine in Kapaa, Kauai is OVER GOAL!!

Fr. Ramelo Somera and his team raised \$46,400 from 19 gifts this week. The new total for St. Catherine is **\$568,600 from 83 gifts**, an average pledge of \$6,851 and **108% of goal!**

Holy Cross in Kalaheo, Kauai is OVER GOAL!!

Congratulations to Fr. Edison Pamintuan and his team. The new total for Holy Cross is **\$311,800 from 68 pledges, that's 108% of goal!**

Congratulations to the outstanding volunteer team at Our Lady of Perpetual Help. This week, their campaign committee collected \$87,400 from 14 pledges – including one for \$20,000. The new total for OLPH is **\$408,400 – 69% of goal!!**

Finalizing Pending Decisions

The Bloc 1 Parishes are in the final stages of active campaigning. As individual campaigns begin to wrap-up, the most important step is to finalize a decision with those parishioners still considering a pledge.
