\$1,407,905 Raised this Week!!

Campaign Surpasses \$19 million

This week, the *With Grateful Hearts* Bloc I Parishes received 499 pledges for a total of **\$1,407,905 – 16% of the Bloc goal!** This is the best fund-raising week of the campaign to date! The Bloc I parishes have raised a total of \$11,622,240 from 2,467 pledges – 128% of the Bloc I Goal! **The campaign has now raised \$19,111,325 from 3,964 gifts.** Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for your hard work!

Good News

St. Pius X on Oahu is OVER GOAL!!!

May 9th and 10th was Commitment Weekend at St. Pius. During Mass, parishioners pledged \$78,210 to bring the new total raised to **\$225,160 from just 71 gifts!** St. Pius is now at **125%** of their \$180,000 goal!

Congratulations to Holy Cross on Kauai! On Commitment Weekend, the parish raised \$206,902 from 72 pledges – 71% of goal! The new total for Holy Cross is **\$533,502 from 150 pledges, that's 184% of goal!**

Congratulations to St. Anthony on Oahu on an incredible Commitment Weekend! Before this weekend, St. Anthony had already raised 219% of the \$225,000 goal. During the weekend, 145 new pledges were collected totaling \$328,178 – another 145% of goal!! The new total for St. Anthony is \$820,533 from 275 gifts – 365% of goal!!! Congratulations!

Commitment Weekend Follow-Up

After Commitment Weekend, parishes will receive numerous in-pew pledge cards marked as “praying.” These are families who remain interested in the campaign but have additional questions that need to be addressed. In the days following Commitment Weekend, take the opportunity to follow-up with these families through a final Phone-a-Thon or individually to continue to receive decisions.

St. Pius X – Honolulu, HI

Having recently celebrated its 50th anniversary, St. Pius X Church is by no means a young parish. With a well-established parishioner base in addition to a very active social ministry, St. Pius X plays an active role in the surrounding community of Manoa. The Road Map for the diocese was developed right here in this very parish with the help of dedicated parishioners. The Road Map is the basis for the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign, and today St. Pius parishioners have done their part in ensuring this pastoral plan becomes a reality.

This past weekend, St. Pius X parish wrapped their campaign up with one final push during Commitment Weekend. Going into the weekend St. Pius had raised approximately 82% of their \$180,000 parish goal. Fr. Gordy, with the help of his hard-working campaign team, was able to raise an incredible \$78,210 from 28 pledges. With those gifts, St. Pius X surpassed the parish campaign goal by raising a total of \$225,160 from 71 gifts! Congratulations on a strong finish to the volunteer team of St. Pius. You all made this possible!
