Campaign Updates

With Grateful Hearts surpasses \$27 Million Raised!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 138 pledges for a total of \$961,625! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$27,452,433 from 5,772 gifts.** The With Grateful Hearts campaign has reached 91% of the \$30 million goal. Many of the Bloc II parishes have received their first pledges, and the remaining parishes are starting orientation meetings and selecting leadership teams. Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for a great start to this Bloc!

Good News

Congratulations to **Sacred Heart in Hawi** on Hawaii! This past week, Fr. Maurice Cardinal raised \$60,000 from four gifts – a 32% week! The new total for Sacred Heart is \$112,200 from 11 gifts. That's 61% of the \$185,000 goal, and a great average gift of \$10,200!

St. Anthony of Padua on Maui received a gift for \$50,000 this week! In addition to what has been raised over the past few weeks, this gift brings the total raised to \$242,200 from six gifts – 39% of the \$620,000 goal. The campaign at St. Anthony of Padua has an amazing average gift of \$40,367!! Great start to the campaign!

Malia Puka O'Kalani on Hawaii raised \$12,000 from one pledge this week. To date, Fr. Samuel Loterto has raised 24% of the \$50,000 goal!

Congratulations to **Our Lady Queen of Angels** on Maui. This week, Fr. Arthur Amian and his team received 12 pledges for a total of \$59,200. Our Lady Queen of Angels has now raised 41% of the \$145,000 goal!

Congratulations to the **Vietnamese Catholic Community!** This week, Fr. Vincent Kien Nguyen raised \$8,040 from two pledges – 8% of the \$100,000 goal. Congratulations on a good start to the campaign!

Tip of the Week

Recruiting Volunteers

The most common factor for success in a campaign is conducting as many personal visits as possible. To accomplish the number of visits needed, each parish will need many volunteers. In preparing for and recruiting the necessary number of committee members, we offer the following suggestions to assist you...

1. Identify potential volunteers from the specific phase! Major Phase Committee members should come from the Major phase.
2. Identify the most active parishioners and recruit them first! Often times people who are the busiest, get the most done.
3. Think of everyone as a potential volunteer! Many parishioners just need to be asked.
4. Stress how important their help will be. "Many hands make light work."
5. Recruit over a two-week period and plan for a follow-up training. Some parishioners might not make the first Orientation, but are willing to help and can attend meetings in the subsequent weeks.
6. Recruit-a-thons! Make your CEC meeting a working one. Bring a cell phone and make phone calls on one night with your fellow committee members. It's easier as a group.
