With Grateful Hearts reaches the \$49 Million Mark!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 821 pledges for a total of \$2,148,070!! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$49,198,663 from 10,725 gifts.** Bloc II Parishes have now received an incredible \$22,578,180 in pledges from 5,032 gifts. That's another 16% increase on the Bloc II goal! Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for all your hard work and support!

Good News

Congratulations to Rev. Mark del Rosario and his campaign committee on a stellar Commitment Weekend! **Star of the Sea Church, Oahu** received 119 pledges this weekend totaling \$288,630 – 30% of their \$940,000 goal! This brings their total raised to \$1,312,216 from 261 gifts. Congratulations on such a strong finish!

Rev. Samuel Loterte and his capable team of volunteers continue to impress, raising an incredible \$338,877 from 127 pledges – 55% of goal in one weekend! This brings the total at **St. Joseph on the Big Island** to \$1,112,852 raised from 244 gifts. Well done!!

Congratulations to **Christ the King, Maui!** Rev. Efren Tomas and his volunteers brought in another \$74,648 from 28 pledges. These pledges are in addition to the \$350,000 raised at last week's in-pew appeal. The new total for the campaign at CTK is now \$976,533 from 366 gifts – just under the \$1 million mark!

Co-Cathedral St. Theresa had an inspiring week, raising over 122% of their total goal in last week's commitment weekend. Fr. William Kunisch and his dedicated volunteers received \$536,492 from 221 pledges. Their total is now \$1,478,692, over 336% of their diocesan goal. Congratulations on surpassing both their diocesan goal and their \$1.3 million challenge goal!

St. Elizabeth, Oahu continued their wonderful work raising \$93,280 from 29 pledges through the phone-a-thons this week. This brings their total to \$707,380 – 73% of their goal. A job well-done by Fr. Tom Purayidathil and his volunteers for this week's great achievements!

Tip of the Week

Pledge Redemption and Parish Share Fund

As the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign comes to a close, there's a shift in mindset from actively campaigning to donor appreciation.

Pledge Redemption

Now that the active stage of our campaign is coming to a close, we must focus our attention on the redemption of pledges already made. There are a couple ways your parish can help in this:

1. Campaign Announcements: Periodic updates for your parishioner base allow donors a glimpse into the successes of the diocesan programs, and to see how their gift made that possible.
2. Consider occasionally making inserts for your weekly bulletin thanking donors for their pledge to *With Grateful Hearts*. Also, including a report on the monies returned to the parish and what those funds are accomplishing would be very helpful.

Parish Share Fund:

Disbursement checks are sent out 6 months after a parish has finished their campaign. Of the money collected at that point, 25% will be returned to the parish. After this initial disbursement, checks will be issued quarterly to each individual parish based on the money collected in that 3-month time period. Keep your parishioners updated about the monies being returned to the parish, and the parish's planned use of the funds.
