With Grateful Hearts reaches the \$55 Million Mark!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 1,036 pledges for a total of \$4,100,746! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$55,802,008 from 12,651 gifts.** Bloc II Parishes have now received an incredible \$27,781,724 in pledges from 6,958 gifts. With Grateful Hearts has now reached 186% of the \$30 million goal - quite an accomplishment considering the turbulent economic times we are experiencing. Once again, we would like to thank all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for all your support. This would not have been possible without your hard work!

Good News

STS. PETER AND PAUL CHURCH, OAHU IS OVER GOAL!!!

Thanks to a productive final push, **Sts. Peter and Paul** was able to surpass their campaign goal! Rev. David Travers and his capable team of volunteers ran a successful in-pew appeal raising \$447,260 from 218 gifts. In all, they have received 320 pledges for a total of \$818,525 - 103% of their \$795,000 goal. Well done!!

Congratulations to Rev. Herman Gomes and his campaign committee on a great Commitment Weekend! **St. Ann, Kaneohe** received an additional \$566,896 from 150 pledges! This brings their total to 533 pledges for a whopping \$2,714,451. They have now reached 357% of their goal. Congratulations on such a well-run campaign!

Immaculate Conception Church, Ewa continues to impress as Rev. Michel Dalton and his volunteers posted their second straight 20% gain week! They received another \$34,100 this week from 8 pledges. They have now received 22 gifts for a total of \$90,300 – 51% of their \$175,000 goal. Keep up the good work!

St. Joseph, Waipahu had the largest Commitment Weekend so far in the With Grateful Hearts campaign. They raised an astounding \$1,256,834 from 528 new gifts. Rev. Gregorio Honorio and his campaign committee have now received a total of 753 gifts for \$2,182,124 - that's 291% of their \$750,000 goal. Incredible work!

Tip of the Week

Pledge Redemption and Parish Share Fund

As the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign comes to a close, there's a shift in mindset from actively campaigning to donor appreciation.

Pledge Redemption

Now that the active stage of our campaign is coming to a close, we must focus our attention on the redemption of pledges already made. There are a couple ways your parish can help in this:

1. Campaign Announcements: Periodic updates for your parishioner base allow donors a glimpse into the successes of the diocesan programs, and to see how their gift made that possible.
2. Consider occasionally using inserts for your weekly bulletin thanking donors for their pledge to *With Grateful Hearts*. Also, including a report on the monies returned to the parish and what those funds are accomplishing would be very helpful.

Parish Share Fund:

The sharing of monies back to the parishes begin six months after the campaign. Of the money collected at that point, 25% will be returned to the parish. After this initial disbursement, checks will be issued quarterly to each individual parish based on the money collected in the previous three-month time period. Keep your parishioners updated about the monies being returned to the parish, and the parish's planned use of the funds.
