With Grateful Hearts surpasses \$56 Million pledged!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 357 pledges for a total of \$1,142,580! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$56,944,588 from 13,008 gifts.** Bloc II Parishes have now received an incredible \$28,938,846 in pledges from 7,316 gifts. With Grateful Hearts has now reached an impressive 190% of the \$30 million goal. This will be the final campaign newsletter. ST. ANTHONY CHURCH, KAILUA IS OVER GOAL!!

Congratulations to Rev. Dennis Koshko and his campaign committee on surpassing their \$2,000,000 goal this week! Thanks to a successful Commitment Weekend, **St. Anthony** received an additional \$401,066 from 109 gifts! This brings their total raised to an incredible \$2,102,536 from 246 – an average pledge of \$8,547. Congratulations on such a successful campaign!

Rev. Marino Angostura and his campaign committee continued their good work this week as they added another 43 pledges for a total of \$120,736. **St. Philomena, Oahu** has now received a total of 178 gifts for \$834,776 – 223% of their \$375,000 goal. Despite a late start, Rev. Marino and his team would not let success escape them in this campaign. Well done!

Congratulations to Rev. Adrian Gervacio and his dedicated team of volunteers on a great Commitment Weekend! **Our Lady of the Mount, Oahu** received an additional \$116,845 from 42 pledges! This brings their total to 105 pledges for an impressive \$308,535. They have now reached 167% of their goal. Congratulations on such a well-run campaign!

Once again, **Immaculate Conception Church, Ewa** posted a strong weekly gain. Rev. Michel Dalton and his volunteers received 9 pledges for a total of \$30,000. They have now received 31 gifts for a total of \$120,300 – 69% of their \$175,000 goal. Keep up the good work!

Pledge Input

The bulk of the 36 Bloc II parishes have just recently completed their Commitment Weekend. As a result, the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign has seen a deluge of new pledges come in. In the last 6 weeks, we've received over 4,200 new pledges.

Please be patient with the campaign office as we work diligently to input all new incoming pledges. Normally all new pledges are immediately entered into our database and by week's end we are current. However, because of this inundation, we expect there to be approximately 2-3 weeks lag time between when a pledge is received and when the donor receives an acknowledgment statement.

If you speak with a fellow parishioner who mentions they haven't yet received a statement, please explain the situation to them. Thank you for understanding!
