Campaign Updates

With Grateful Hearts surpasses \$28 Million Raised!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 63 pledges for a total of \$447,190! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$28,371,873 from 5,882 gifts.** The With Grateful Hearts campaign has reached 94% of the \$30 million goal. Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for a great start to this Bloc!

Good News

SACRED HEART – HAWI is OVER GOAL!!

Congratulations to Rev. Maurice Cardinal and his team at Sacred Heart. This week, the parish raised \$53,500 from 12 gifts, bringing the total raised to \$199,500 from 28 gifts – 108% of the \$185,000 goal!

VIETNAMESE CATHOLIC COMMUNITY is OVER GOAL!!

Congratulations to Rev. Vincent Kien Nguyen and his team. In just the third week of the campaign, the Vietnamese Catholic Community has surpassed the \$100,000 goal. This week, \$82,960 was raised from 11 gifts – that's 83% of goal!

St. Roch in Kahuku had a great week of fund-raising. Rev. Sydney Fernandes and his team raised \$46,800 from 5 pledges this week – 46% of the \$100,000 goal.

Congratulations to **St. Joseph** in Hilo! Rev. Samuel Loterte in his first month at the parish has raised \$143,000 from five pledges – 23% of the \$610,000 goal. That's a great average gift of \$28,600!!

Star of the Sea on Oahu continues to do great work in this campaign. This week, Fr. Mark del Rosario received five pledges for a total of \$61,000! Star of the Sea has now raised \$177,000 from ten gifts – 19% of the \$940,000 goal and a great average gift of \$17,700!!

Question: Why do people give?

While any individual answer may vary, there are four very specific and basic reasons why parishioners choose to support the Campaign:

1. Because they believe in the mission and goals of the project.
2. Because they trust the leadership.
3. Because a fellow parishioner is involved with the request.

Remember - Most parishioners want to know what is anticipated of them in regard to their campaign gift. All households are asked to consider a specific request to provide a benchmark for giving.
