Campaign Updates Over \$29 Million raised !!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 90 pledges for a total of \$873,780! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$29,245,653 from 5,972 gifts.** The With Grateful Hearts campaign has reached 97% of the \$30 million goal. Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for a great start to this Bloc!

Good News

Congratulations to the **Molokai Catholic Community!** This week, Rev. Clyde Guerreiro and his team raised \$32,900 from four gifts. The new total for the campaign on Molokai is \$78,900 - 63% of the \$125,000 goal!

Holy Rosary on Maui raised 25% of goal this week! Rev. Patrick Freitas and the volunteers have raised \$48,880 from 14 gifts – 61% of the \$80,000 goal!

The **Vietnamese Catholic Community** continues to do well. This week the parish raised \$32,500 from 10 gifts - an additional 32% of goal!

Congratulations to **Sts. Michael/Peter and Paul** in Waialua! Rev. Bert Lock and his volunteers raised \$49,600 this week from 8 pledges. The new total for Sts. Michael/Peter and Paul is \$93,600 from 15 pledges – 31% of goal!

St. Joseph in Hilo had a 9% week! Rev. Samuel Loterte and the leadership team at the parish have raised \$198,000 towards the \$610,000 goal from 8 gifts. This is a great average gift of \$24,750! Congratulations!

Tip of the Week

Discussing the Economic Climate during Visits

Over the last year, the economic climate has been more uncertain than in the last 8 years. The economy has become a daily topic of discussion, especially in conversations about charitable giving.

During your visits, talk with parishioners about their situation. Incorporate the economy into your presentation.

“These are difficult times for many people, but our needs are greater than ever. This campaign can provide so many resources to help our parishioners and those in need to weather the storm.”

The parishes running campaigns during the Pilot and Bloc I Phases encountered some of the worst economic news. However, parishioners continued to give generously, and the campaign at those parishes was a huge success – many raised over 200% of goal.

Though times are tough and volunteers should be judicious in an approach and during requests, they can be confident that parishioners are responding generously. The Catholics of Hawaii faithfully continue to support the church and its ministries.
