With Grateful Hearts surpasses \$30 Million Goal

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 126 pledges for a total of \$1,036,880!! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$30,282,533 from 6,098 gifts.** The campaign has surpassed the \$30 million goal! All of the Bloc II parishes are still beginning or in the process of running campaigns. Focus and hard work from volunteers will continue to make this campaign a huge success! Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers!

Good News

MOLOKAI CATHOLIC COMMUNITY IS OVER GOAL!!

Congratulations to the **Molokai Catholic Community!** This week, Rev. Clyde Guerreiro and his team raised \$77,000 from seven gifts – 61% of goal! The new total for the campaign on Molokai is \$155,900 - 125% of the \$125,000 goal and a great average gift of \$9,744.

St. Theresa in Mountain View raised 36% of goal this week! Rev. Salvador Bringas and the volunteers have raised \$114,500 from 13 gifts – 79% of the \$145,000 goal!

Malia Puka O'Kalani on Hawaii raised \$14,00 this week from three gifts – 28% of goal. The new total for the parish is \$32,000 from five gifts – 64% of the \$50,000 goal!

Congratulations to **Sts. Michael/Peter and Paul** in Waialua! Rev. Bert Lock and his volunteers raised \$57,080 this week from 17 pledges. The new total for Sts. Michael/Peter and Paul is \$150,680 from 32 pledges – 49% of goal!

Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Kaneohe had a 27% week! Rev. Paolo Kosaka and the leadership team at the parish have raised \$32,400 from two pledges in one week!

St. Rita on Maui raise another 19% of goal this week with nine pledges totaling \$20,100. Congratulations to Rev. Patrick Freitas and his team on achieving 69% of goal!

Tip of the Week

Thanks to the hard work and generosity of many, over \$30 million has now been pledged in the *With Grateful Hearts* Campaign. Some volunteers worry that this may actually discourage the support of future parishioners. In fact, some donors may now ask, "If the diocese is over goal, why do you need my pledge?"

First, the good news is that success is usually one of the best invitations to future support. Many feel a greater confidence in organizations that are able to attain their goals and are more likely to lend their support to these organizations.

It is also important to share with donors that based on the sharing formulas, nearly half of this \$30 million in pledges will be returned directly to the parishes for their uses. This means that only about half of the goals detailed in the diocese's case statement have been funded. It is also important to highlight to parishioners the needs of the local parish, since their gift will determine the monies that will be returned to their specific parish.

Don't let the current success weaken your confidence. Be encouraged! It is a time to be proud of the generosity of so many. It is time to continue on in this success inviting others to complete the good work that has begun.
