With Grateful Hearts hits \$39 Million Mark!!

This week, the With Grateful Hearts campaign received 464 pledges for a total of \$1,848,077!! **The overall campaign total raised is now \$39,909,121 from 7,880 gifts.** The campaign is now just \$81,000 short of hitting the \$40 million level, quite an impressive feat!! To date, Bloc II Parishes have received \$13,253,758 in pledges from 2,181 gifts - 99.9% of goal! Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for all your hard work and support!

Good News

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL ON OAHU IS OVER GOAL!!!

Congratulations to Rev. Paolo Kosaka and his committee of volunteers on a great Commitment Weekend! **Our Lady of Mount Carmel on Oahu** raised \$127,220 from 50 pledges – an incredible 106% of goal in one weekend! This brings them to a total of \$224,120 from 72 gifts – 187% of their goal!

St. Patrick Church on Oahu had a strong week of fund raising, posting a 33% gain. Fr. Clarence Guerreiro and his committee received 19 pledges for a total of \$158,300. They now sit at \$406,725 from 58 gifts – 85% of their \$480,000 goal. Keep up the good work!

St. Joseph Church on the Big Island had a great week, raising an impressive \$78,225 from 18 pledges. Rev. Samuel Loterte and his team of volunteers have now received a total of \$540,625 from 53 gifts – 89% of their \$610,000 goal!

The Vietnamese Catholic Community finished up their campaign this past weekend with a solid \$126,700 from 47 pledges – another 126% of their \$100,000 goal. Rev. Vincent Kien Nguyen and his team have now raised an incredible 528% of their campaign goal! Excellent work!

Tip of the Week

Finalizing Pending Decisions

The Bloc II Parishes are in the final stages of active campaigning. As individual campaigns begin to wrap-up, the most important step is to finalize a decision with those parishioners still considering a pledge.

If you have any remaining pending decisions, work to close those gifts!

For the parishes which have already completed Commitment Weekend, there are still several parishioners who indicated that they are praying about their decision. A phone call to answer any questions can help someone finalize their decision.

If your parish has not yet had Commitment Weekend, now is the time to make a final push for decisions. Try to complete any outstanding pledges before the appeal in Mass, or emphasize that the donor can come ready with a decision on the final weekend of the campaign.
