### CAMPAIGN SURPASSES \$1 Million Raised!!

Thanks to the efforts of every volunteer, pastor and leadership team member, the campaign has exceeded the \$1 million mark, for a new total of \$1,249,680!!

The Pilot Parishes have raised a collective \$382,00 in just one week, topping last week's total raised by more than \$100,000.

**SACRED HEARTS - LANAI IS OVER GOAL!!** Congratulations to Fr. Ferdinand Ragasa and his team at Sacred Hearts on becoming the first parish over goal. Since last week, Sacred Hearts has raised \$85,800 of their \$145,00 goal - an incredible week of fund raising!

Congratulations to Fr. Khanh Pham-Nguyen and Blessed Sacrament for jumping 46% in one week! To date, Blessed Sacrament has raised \$66,900 of their \$135,000 goal and will continue to reach out to all remaining households within the parish.
