## Campaign Updates

The *With Grateful Hearts* campaign received \$317,983 from 67 pledges, an increase of 11% for the Pilot Parishes this week. The parishes have consistently raised \$300,000 or more every week for the last month. At the current pace, we could be over the Pilot Phase goal in just 3 weeks. Thank you to all the campaign volunteers for their work this week! Great job all!

### GOOD NEWS

**CONGRATULATIONS! St. Stephen's Catholic Church is OVER GOAL!** Fr. Khanh Pham-Nguyen and his team raised \$34,500 from 12 gifts this week. To date, the parish has raised \$139,750 from 31 pledges—103% of the \$135,000 goal!

**Holy Trinity** has surpassed the 50% mark! Fr. Gary Secor and his team at Holy Trinity raised \$34,000 this week from 6 decisions for a new total of \$370,460 and an average gift of \$13,230!!

Congratulations to Fr. Edgar Brillantes and the volunteers at **Our Lady of Sorrows** on a wonderful week, raising \$68,460 from 20 gifts. To date, the parish has raised \$303,985 from 56

## Tip of the Week

### Pending Decisions

*Remember*, in order to receive a timely decision we recommend the following...

- Schedule a specific follow-up date while at the initial visit. This avoids playing “*phone tag*” in the coming week and will help stress the importance of the campaign.
- Keep the pledge card with you! Not all households will be ready to make a decision at the initial visit and will need time (usually just a few days) to determine their pledge
- Ask for their decision. If a household you are visiting has made their decision, ask them to fill out their commitment card so that you can report it to your pastor and the committee at the next meeting.
