Campaign Updates

Bloc I Parishes Raise \$6,000,000!!

This week, the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign received 101 pledges for a total of \$516,160! To date, the Bloc I parishes have raised \$6,047,304 from 672 pledges - with an average gift of \$8,999! **The campaign has now raised \$11,906,689 from 2,163 gifts.**

Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for your hard work!

Good News

St. Theresa in Kekaha, Kauai is OVER GOAL!! This week, Fr. Fred and his team raised \$41,800 from 7 gifts - a new campaign total of \$258,000 from 39 pledges. They are now at **112%** of goal. Congratulations!

Congratulations to **St. John Vianney** in Kailua, Oahu. This week volunteers collected 8 new pledges for a total of \$86,400 - **12% of goal in one week!** Fr. Tom Gross and the volunteers have now raised a total of \$351,900 from 32 pledges. That's an average gift of \$10,997!

Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Ewa Beach, Oahu raised \$68,300 from 15 pledges this week to bring the total raised to \$239,300 from 40 gifts. Fr. Scott Bush and his team have already raised **40%** of the \$595,000 goal!!

Parish Focus

St. Anthony – Kalihi, Oahu

Founded in 1916, St. Anthony Catholic Church has nurtured Catholic faith while providing caring service to the Kalihi community for the last ninety-three years. Its rich history and active parishioners make it one of the more lively communities in the diocese. The parishioners at St. Anthony Church continue to minister to the needs of the community, securing a stable and prosperous future.

The goal at St. Anthony Church for the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign is \$225,000. Fr. Gus has assembled an effective volunteer team, and has already received over 20 gifts for the campaign. This past week, Fr. Gus and his committee raised \$36,000 from just 4 gifts. The new total raised for St. Anthony Church is \$145,000 from 21 gifts. That's already 64% of the overall goal, and they've only just begun to make personal visits! Congratulations to Fr. Gus and his fine leadership team on a great start to the campaign!

Tip of the Week

Setting Deadlines

Bloc I of the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign is more than halfway complete. The next month is critical to maintaining campaign momentum before Phone-a-Thons and Commitment Weekends begin.

One way to ensure timely follow-up is to set a deadline for yourself and fellow parishioners. Aim to complete your first round of phone calls within a week of receiving the packets. Set an appointment for a follow-up during your initial visit. Let parishioners know that their decision is important - their pledge will make a difference in the amount raised and will encourage others to give.

Aim to have a signed pledge card to turn in for each report meeting. By setting a deadline or weekly goal you can maintain a high level of activity – the first step in being a great volunteer.
