The **With Grateful Hearts** campaign surpasses \$6 Million!! Every Pilot Parish has now exceeded goal, many raising much more! The Pilot Parishes have raised more than \$5 million on a \$2.78 million goal! The Pilots are now at 180% of the phase goal.

Thank you to the campaign leadership and each volunteer for their continued hard work to make this campaign such a success!

Bloc I of the campaign has officially begun after the week of kickoffs January 9 – 16th! As the Pilot Phase parishes conclude the final follow-up in their campaigns, the Bloc I parishes will be gearing up for the start of leadership and volunteer meetings.

Sacred Heart in Pahoa is OVER GOAL!! The parish Commitment Weekend on January 10th and 11th was a huge success, raising \$135,075 from 67 pledges. Sacred Heart in Pahoa has now raised **\$162,975 from 75 gifts, 112% of goal!** Congratulations to the Sacred Heart team!

Bloc I Kickoffs

Bloc I of the **With Grateful Hearts** campaign has officially begun! The kickoff events began on January 9th at Maria Lanakila in Maui. Next, Bishop Larry, Fr. Marc Alexander, and Fr. Gary Secor traveled to Kauai where the Hilton Kauai Beach Resort hosted close to 170 pastors, lay leaders, and parishioners eager to learn more about **With Grateful Hearts**. St. Philomena opened its parish hall for the January 14th O'ahu kickoff, hosting nine parishes slated to start the campaign in Bloc I. Finally, the campaign traveled to Hawai'i for two consecutive kickoffs held at Holy Rosary – Pahala and Immaculate Heart of Mary in Papaikou.

In total, nearly 600 people attended these kickoff meetings! The sentiment after each kickoff was much the same, "when can we get started?"

Special thanks to our hosts on each island – Maria Lanakila, St. Philomena, Holy Rosary, and Immaculate Heart of Mary. The time and care invested in the preparations for the events truly made each a huge success!
