Campaign Updates

This week, the **With Grateful Hearts** Bloc I parishes received 29 pledges for a total of \$274,870. To date, the Bloc I parishes have raised \$1,640,110 from 85 pledges with an average gift of \$19,295! **Overall, the campaign has now raised \$7,413,593 from 1,570 gifts.**

The Kauai parishes report new funds raised this week – \$61,400 at Immaculate Conception and \$34,000 at Saint Catherine! Congratulations to the pastors and leadership teams for such a wonderful start to the campaign!!

Thank you to all of the parish leadership, priests, campaign and parish administrators, and volunteers for their hard work!

Congratulations to Fr. William Shannon at **Immaculate Conception on Kauai!** In the past week, Fr. Shannon raised **\$61,400 from 6 pledges** - 22% of the \$285,000 goal. Immaculate Conception has a fantastic average gift of \$10,233.

Congratulations to Fr. Jerry Avisia at Our Lady of Lourdes in Honokaa on **Hawaii!!** This week, Fr. Avisia made six visits to parishioners, and received **five gifts for a total of \$42,000!** Our Lady of Lourdes has raised 24% of goal and has a great average gift of \$8,400!!
